

Eligibility

- Chronically homeless for at least one year or four episodes of homelessness in three years
- Must have a disability (documented or disability certification)

Documents Required:


- Florida ID
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate
- DD 214 (applies to veterans)
- Disability Certification or proof of disability income

Special Funding:

- Assist housed clients with rental housing assistance (70%-100%)
- Assist with utilities through LI-HEAP, the City of Orlando, Florida Hospital, Orange County, and HUD
- Assist with move in kits/food kits through local churches, community donors, and the Central Florida Foundation



Our Mission



All About PSH

Our Permanent Supportive Housing Program started in July 2015 in response to the rising need of Central Florida's homeless population. This program is based on the Housing First Model, a new approach on providing housing as quickly as possible to those experiencing chronic homelessness.

The clients that we serve through this program are chronically homeless individuals who have been living with a disability. We use a patient care delivery model that coordinates medical services to ensure the necessary care is provided when and where it's needed.

We provide our clients with affordable, community-based housing and services needed to help them achieve and maintain stability in their lives.
